**EDUCATIONAL TOWN HALL MEETING ON AMERICAN RECOVERY AND  
REINVESTMENT ACT PRESENTED BY IDAAC**

INDIANAPOLIS – The Indiana Democratic African American Caucus (IDAAC) will host an Educational Town Hall Meeting on Saturday, April 11, 2009 from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., at the Julia Carson building, 300 E Fall Creek Pkwy on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor conference room B.

Marshawn Wolley, President of IDAAC will moderate this event which is free and open to the public.

The purpose of this event is to inform the public on the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
